Please feed students before bringing them for performances. Only water bottles will be allowed near costumes. Students should wear clean new pink tights and pink ballet slippers that are in good condition. Hair should be worn in a ballet bun with hair pieces securely fastened. Students should wear a dress or something similar that will cover their costume as the students will be allowed to watch part of the show in a designated area with adult supervision. Please have students name on their slippers and costumes. Please write down any questions you may have and leave them on the desk in the office. Rehearsals are very busy and we try to keep to the time scheduled. Parents should plan on staying for the entire performance as all students have worked hard to present this program. All students will have a final bow on stage. After the performance please pick up your child as soon as possible.
